Pat, very well known to many of us as the "voice" of Mountrath Co Op. Marts on the Rushin Road where he was a member of the Auctioneering team for thirty years. At Parish level Pat was Chair of the Pastoral Council and was always so willing to help where he could and t'was many a Charity Auction he brought to life with his distinctive and special auctioneering skills. Pat, I understand was a founding member of Mountrath Macra in the 1960's and was one of the team who instigated (and indeed built) the building we know as "The Macra Hall" on Main St., (before the days of cement blocks or Readymix) (Mountrath Macra Hall is still going strong) Pat and the Macra Team of his day were skilled debaters and it's many a trophy they brought home after winning many a debating competition around the country.
