Our new Pope - Pope Leo XIV (14th)

As I finish my Newsletters this Thursday evening, news is just coming through from Rome that we have a new pope.

Our new pope, Pope Leo 14th - Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost, hails from Chicago, USA. He was ordained priest in 1981 as a member of the Augustine Order. Fr. Robert was pastor of vocations and director of missions for the Augustinian order in Chicago and worked in Peru for several years. He also served as a parish pastor, diocesan official, seminary teacher and vicar. He served two terms as the head of the Augustinian order, until 2013. He was created Cardinal by Pope Francis in September 2023. He is fluent in about 6 languages and holds dual American-Peruvian nationality.
