Traditionally Burglaries increase by 20% over the winter months of October to March. Some simple methods can make your home and premises less vulnerable to Criminal Attack.

。 Lighting around the house on a sensor or photocell.

- . Lighting inside on timers

  Natural Surveillance- trim shrubs down to lm and trees up to 2
  m.
- 。 Use Bogus Caller Cards
- 。 Close Curtains during hours of Darkness.

#### What Attracts the Burglar:

- 。 Signs of being unoccupied.
- 。 Open Windows
- 。 Hidden keys
- 。 A build up of Post / Milk, etc.
- 。 *No alarms.*
- 。 High vegetation
- 。 Ladders or tools in easy reach
- 。 Easy access to the rear of your house
- 。 Poor lighting or house lights on at the wrong time.
